Dear parents/carers,

NEU Strike Action

Further to our letter dated 26th January 2023 regarding proposed upcoming NEU strike action. I am writing to give you as much notice as possible about our arrangements for Wednesday 1st February 2023:

- All of Year 11 are expected to attend; all year 11 provision will take place on the main site (Annandale Road).
- There will be a small number of additional groups running; tutors will let you know individually if your child is expected in.
- Breakfast, break and lunch will run as normal for students on site. Transport arrangements for students expected to attend will be communicated through your child's tutor.
- If your child is not expected to attend but you would like a FSM for your child, please communicate through your child's tutor and we can arrange a time for you to collect a packed lunch.

I am sorry that in some cases you will have to make alternative arrangements for your child at short notice, and/or that they will experience disruption to their education.

Please note that even though our current plans may be to open to the students listed above we may have to reduce the list of groups/pupils that can attend school even further on the morning of 1st February 2023. Should this be the case you will be notified initially via text and a follow up phone call by our pastoral team.

A packed lunch will be available for collection but not be able to attend school due to the strike action. If you would like to request a packed lunch please contact your child's tutor via the end of day debrief calls giving the name of the student(s) no later than end of day Monday 30th January 2023. We will then let you know on Tuesday the 31st January the time the packed lunch can be collected from Aspire.
